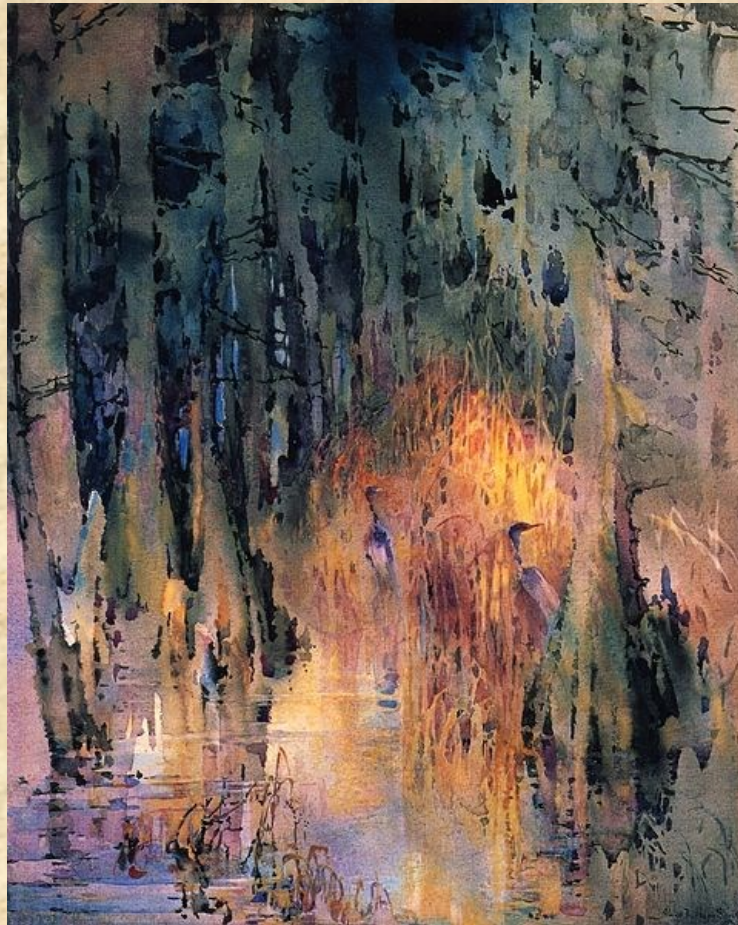

Bayou Scene (1920) by Alice Ravenel Huger Smith

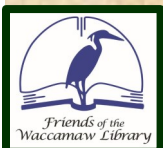
